As most of you know, Air Scharnell is big in the Combat Competition. Well, our thoughts in July was to come out with our own line of combat plane. About the time we had all the product to start building, had the blueprints drawn as to what we were going to do and ready to begin, we received an email from TEAMseaholm asking if we were interested in buying his combat plane line "The Avenger".

TEAMseaholm has the #1 selling combat plane in the United States at most the Combat meets Team Scharnell has been to, approximately 80% to 90% of the planes flown there were Avengers. After a lot of thought and proposals, Air Scharnell now owns the Avenger Combat Plane line. The TEAMseaholm Avenger is now the Team Scharnell Avenger. We will be manufacturing and selling the Avenger right here in our store. This is quite a project for us as we will be selling online now too. The inventory is to arrive at the store the weekend of August 11th. We have been looking into vendors to get our products from and to laser cut our kit parts. The Avenger is an awesome plane to fly, not only do people love to fly them in combat and do well with them (the Avenger was the plane flown at the NATS in Muncie Indiana which won most of the combat events), there are also those RC pilots out there that just love to fly the plane for sport! We are hoping to be up and running the Week of August 13th and getting kits together to sell. We have an idea of what the inventory will be when it arrives, but won't see what we will need to complete multiple kits until it is actually here. We are hoping the future of Air Scharnell will include kitting other planes also. Our long term plan is to eventually be able to get laser cutters here in the store to cut out many different air plane parts. Our first priority though will be to get the Avenger back up and going and to design a upgraded one in 2008 which will be even better than the one which is being sold now.

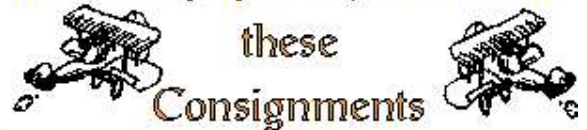
We have a customer looking for a Midwest Zero 40 size Cowl. Does anyone have one and want to sell it, or do you know where to have one made?
